Auction Rules and Procedures

All Bidding will require possession of a bid number. Your personal bid number is located on the upper right hand corner of your entry ticket.

~Silent Auction~

1. Please print **your** bid number and the amount of your bid neatly and clearly in the space provided when bidding on silent auction items. Be sure the bid sheet you are writing on matches the item you want to bid on. Bidding errors and practical jokes will back up the cash-out process for everyone in attendance.
2. The minimum raise amount for all silent auction items is \$5.00. Bidding can continue on the back of the bid sheet after the front has been completed.
3. The silent auction will close at 6:45pm. Please do not attempt to assist by picking up bid sheets and handing them to our staff.
4. Our cashiers must enter data on ALL silent auction items before bidders can cash out. The cash out table will be closed during this process (20-30 minutes). For your convenience, one list of silent auction results will be distributed when all items have been entered. Please bring any discrepancies to the attention of our cash out table at this time.

~Cash-Out Procedure~

All purchases must be made in full at the end of the evening with the exception of credit card purchases (in which you will have a week to make a donation through *paypal* on our Caregivers website). Please do not cash out until an announcement has been made. You will be given a receipt for your records and your taxes.
